With the guidance of experienced, qualified, and creative teachers, New School provides the student a safe, empowering environment that promotes an independent learner with a sense of responsibility for learning.

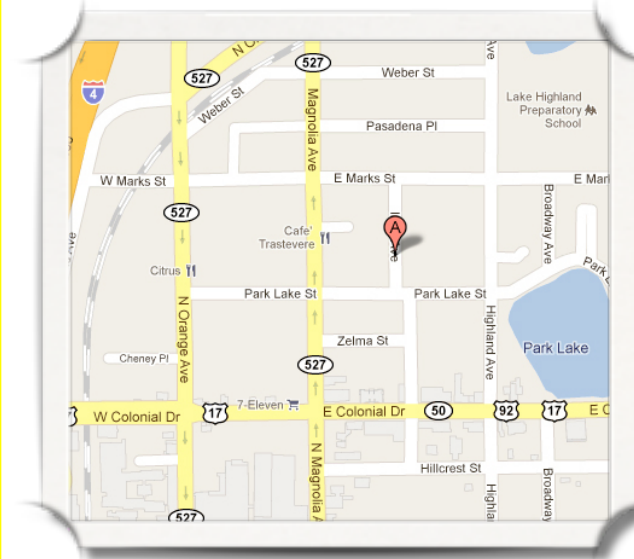

Tutoring vs Remediation
